Proposed Mounding - slope angle 1:4 on road side and between 1:4 and 1:6 on Kingcausie Estate side.

Extra Heavy Standard Trees to be Common Beech, Common Hornbeam, Small Leaved Lime and Sycamore

Align drainage to retain as many trees as possible

Embankment graded out to minimise the visual impact of large embankment on B979 and surrounding properties.

False cutting ch.102165 - ch.102840. Minimum height 1m above edge of carriageway.

Mounding locally adjusted to avoid existing trees to be retained.

Extra Heavy Standard Trees to be Common Beech and Sycamore

Mature Specimen tree to be retained, location indicative.

Mound outer slopes generally graded out to maximum extent possible within LMA, allowing for protection of existing trees and root zones.

2 no. Mitigation squirrel dreys put up in woodland block in advanced works contract. 30/50m buffer zone to be maintained around boxes.

33 no. Mitigation bat boxes put up in woodland block in advanced works contract. 30m buffer zone to be maintained around boxes.

No landscape operations (construction or maintenance) should compromise integrity of organic production on adjacent farmland.
