#### ROAD TRAFFIC

The A84/A85 Trunk Road (Callander) (30mph Speed Limit)
Order 2001

Made Coming into force

18<sup>th</sup> July 2001 3<sup>rd</sup> August 2001

The Scottish Ministers, in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 84(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a) and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, and having complied with Part II of the Secretary of State's Traffic Orders (Procedure) (Scotland) Regulations 1987(b), hereby make the following Order:

- 1. This Order may be cited as the A84/A85 Trunk Road (Callander) (30mph Speed Limit) Order 2001 and shall come into force on 3<sup>rd</sup> August 2001.
- 2. No person shall drive any motor vehicle on the length of road specified in the Schedule to this Order at a speed exceeding 30mph.
- 3. The Trunk Roads (Restricted Roads) (Perth and Kinross) Order 1975(c) shall be varied to the effect that paragraph 4(a) of the Schedule to that Order is deleted.
- 4. The Trunk Roads (40mph Speed Limit) (Perth and Kinross) (Consolidation) Order 1974(d) shall be varied to the effect that paragraph 4(a) of the Schedule to that Order is deleted.
