ROAD TRAFFIC

The Tore-Ullapool Trunk Road (A835) (Contin Village) (30mph Speed Limit) Order 1993

Made Coming into force 17th March 1993 29th March 1993

The Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by sections 84(1) and 84(2) and section 124(1)(d) of Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, and having complied with Part II of the Secretary of State's Traffic Orders (Procedure) (Scotland) Regulations 1987(b), hereby makes the following Order:

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Tore-Ullapool Trunk Road (A835) (Contin Village) (30mph Speed Limit) Order 1993 and shall come into force on 29th March 1993.
- 2. No person shall drive or cause to be driven any vehicle at a speed exceeding 30mph on the length of road specified in the Schedule to this Order.
- 3. The Trunk Roads (Restricted Roads) (Ross and Cromarty) Amendment Order 1984(c) is hereby revoked.
