THE A96 ABERDEEN-INVERNESS TRUNK ROAD (NAIRN)  
(RESTRICTED ROAD AND 40MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 1994

Made	14th March 1994
Coming into force	24th March 1994

The Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by sections 82(2), 83(1) and 84(1) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, and having complied with Part II of the Secretary of State's Traffic Orders (Procedure) (Scotland) Regulations 1987(b), hereby makes the following Order:

1. This Order may be cited as The A96 Aberdeen-Inverness Trunk Road (Nairn) (Restricted Road and 40mph Speed Limit) Order 1994 and shall come into force on 24th March 1994.
2. The length of road specified in Schedule 1 to this Order shall become a restricted road for the purposes of section 81(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (which imposes a speed limit of 30mph on a restricted road).
3. No person shall drive or cause to be driven any vehicle at a speed exceeding 40mph on the length of road specified in Schedule 2 to this Order.

#### Schedule 1

That length of the Aberdeen-Inverness Trunk Road (A96) known as Forres Road at Nairn in Highland Region from a point 125 metres or thereby south east of its junction with the A939 Grantown on Spey Road in a south easterly direction to a point 213 metres or thereby south east of the said junction, a distance of 88 metres or thereby.

#### Schedule 2

That length of the Aberdeen-Inverness Trunk Road (A96) known as Forres Road at Nairn in Highland Region from a point 213 metres or thereby south east of its junction with the A939 Grantown on Spey Road to a point 150 metres or thereby east of the access road to Balmakeith Industrial Estate, a distance of 455 metres or thereby.
