**Environmental Assessment (Scotland) Act 2005: Section 8(1)

Screening Determination

I refer to the Screening report prepared for the above, using the criteria set out in Schedule 2 of the Environmental Assessment (Scotland) Act 2005, which was submitted to the SEA Gateway on 19 September 2024.

Responses from the Consultation Authorities were received between 8 October and 25 October 2024, whose overall opinion was that there was no likelihood of significant environmental effects.
