### ROAD TRAFFIC

The A82 Trunk Road (Fort Augustus) (Prohibition on Waiting, Loading and Unloading) Order 202[]

The Scottish Ministers make the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 1(1), 2(1) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(**a**), and all other powers enabling them to do so.

In accordance with section 1(1) of that Act, they consider it expedient to make this Order to avoid danger to persons or other traffic using the lengths of road specified in the schedule, or for preventing the likelihood of any such danger arising, and to facilitate the passage of vehicular traffic on the length of road so specified.

They have complied with Parts II and III of the Secretary of State's Traffic Orders (Procedure) (Scotland) Regulations 1987(**b**).

#### Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the A82 Trunk Road (Fort Augustus) (Prohibition on Waiting, Loading and Unloading) Order 202[] and comes into force on [] 202[].

#### **Prohibition on waiting**

**2.** No person may use, or permit the use of, any vehicle to wait, load or unload on the lengths of road, or a part or parts of the lengths of road, specified in the schedule when a prohibition is identified as applying to those lengths of road, or a part or parts of those lengths of road, by means of a traffic sign of the type described in item 19 (diagram 636 – temporary prohibition of waiting except for loading and unloading) of the sign table in Part 6 of schedule 13 of the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016(c).

- **3.** No prohibition imposed by this Order applies to—
  - (a) a vehicle being used in an emergency for fire brigade, ambulance, police or coastguard purposes, or
  - (b) a vehicle being used for carrying out the works.

# **SCHEDULE**

Article 2

## SPECIFIED LENGTHS OF ROAD

### West Side

**1.** That length of the A82 Dalnottar – Inverness Trunk Road at Fort Augustus from a point 30 metres or thereby north east of the north kerbline of Bunoich Brae junction south west and south for a distance of 546 metres or thereby.

#### East Side

**2.** That length of the A82 Dalnottar – Inverness Trunk Road at Fort Augustus from a point 30 metres or thereby north east opposite the north kerbline of Bunoich Brae junction south west and south for a distance of 546 metres or thereby.
